



Caring Continence Assessments

PRIVATE FEE SCHEDULE – FY 2027

A continence assessment can help identify your individual requirements and provide clinical recommendations to support appropriate product selection, management strategies and funding.

A comprehensive Continence Clinical Nurse Consultant (CNC) assessment is typically 4–6 hours, charged at \$175.18 per hour.

Shorter consultations available by request where a full assessment and report are not required.

- **Hourly Rate:** **\$175.00 per hour** (*Standard Weekday Daytime*)
\$250.12 per hour (Saturday)
- **Flexible Billing:** Billed in **15-minute increments** for brief check-ins or ongoing support.

Follow-up consultations may be used to review progress, discuss recommendations, review continence products or address specific continence management needs.

Once your initial plan is established, all ongoing support, reviews, and quick check-ins are billed flexibly in **15-minute increments** based strictly on the time used.

You will receive a transparent quote for these total hours prior to your first appointment.

What is included in your initial assessment

- **Live Video Consultation:** A 60-to-90-minute comprehensive, one-on-one telehealth session to discuss your medical history, current routines, and goals.
- **Clinical Chart Analysis:** Expert review and analysis of your bladder and bowel diaries to pinpoint patterns and issues.
- **Tailored Product Sourcing:** Researching, matching, and organizing targeted sample products or specialized equipment options for you to trial.
- **Formal Continence Management Plan:** A customized, clinically robust care plan detailing daily strategies, fluid schedules, and long-term management advice.
- **Subsidy application Support:** Preparation of clinical documentation to assist you in assessing relevant government funding or equipment schemes (eg CAPs)

Telehealth – No travel costs

CCA provides Australia-wide telehealth continence assessments from the comfort and privacy of your own home.

No travel time or mileage fees are charged.

This helps reduce the overall cost of accessing specialist continence nursing compared with services where travel time and mileage may be added to the consultation fee.

Payment

Private clients are responsible for payment of the agreed consultation fees. The assessment fee will be discussed with you before your appointment, so you understand the expected cost.
