My name is Ceilidh Meo and I'm the Managing Director of the Long Road Olive Co-op Ltd.

This co-op is newly minted, a labour of love by our Board over the last two years, and it feels extra special to be launching this venture with and for small scale olive growers in the UN-designated International Year of Co-operatives. The theme for this year is "co-operatives build a better world" and it is a vision that I, and the Board of Directors, wholeheartedly believe in and support.


