Caring Continence Assessments (CCA) provides specialist continence assessment and clinical advice to home care providers supporting adults with bladder and bowel continence needs.

CCA can work with home care providers to identify continence needs, recommend appropriate products and provide clear clinical recommendations that can be incorporated into the clients' care plan.

Services may include:

- Comprehensive bladder and bowel continence assessments
- Review of continence products and product requirements
- Recommendations for continence management and toileting routines
- Assessment of functional and environmental factors affecting continence
- Continence product selection and prescription recommendations
- Clinical reports with practical recommendations for the client and care team
- Catheter-related continence education and advice where appropriate
- Liaison with the client's GP, allied health professionals or care team, with consent

Fees

Continence Assessment, Report & Prescription

\$175.18 per hour

Minimum: 4 hours

Maximum: 6 hours

The assessment time includes preparation, review of relevant information, clinical assessment, and preparation of the report and recommendations.

Follow-up Consultation

\$175.18 per hour

Saturday rate

\$250.12 per hour

The amount of follow-up time will be discussed and agreed according to the client's individual needs.

Telehealth

Assessments can be provided Australia-wide via telehealth, providing a convenient and private option for clients who are unable to attend a clinic.

No travel time or mileage fees are charged for telehealth appointments.

Where a home care provider requests a service on behalf of a client, appropriate consent and service arrangements will be confirmed before the assessment.
