OPEN SECTION

Open exhibitors are those who have nominated to compete in the Open Section or those who are no longer eligible to compete in the Intermediate Section.

INTERMEDIATE SECTION

Intermediate exhibitors are those who are no longer eligible for entry in the Novice Section and have not nominated for the Open Section. May elect to remain in Intermediate Section for three years, even if won a class in the Intermediate Section and qualifying for Open Section.

NOVICE SECTION

Novice exhibitors are those who have been growing orchids, or a member of the club, for less than three (3) years and have not won in the novice section or have not nominated for any other section.

For Intermediate and Novice Sections, the growing period for 2020 and 2021 will not count towards the time period in either section.

1. All exhibits must be benched **no later than 6PM on the Friday**, the day of setting up. No exhibit shall be removed from the show benches before closing time of the Show (3PM Sunday).
2. All exhibits must have been owned and grown by the exhibitor for at least three months prior to the Show and must be a member of the Sale and District Orchid Club Inc (SADOC) or a registered Orchid Club.
3. Exhibitors must be a member of the Club prior to the Show. At the discretion of the Club members from other Clubs may be invited to exhibit.
4. It is the responsibility of exhibitors to make their own transport arrangements. Every exhibit must be branded with the owner's name, but not visible to the judging panel.
5. While care and reasonable caution for the safety and security of exhibits will be exercised, the Club will accept no responsibility for loss or damage.
6. All exhibits/exhibitors shall conform to the rules of the Club as defined in the SADOC rules. The Show Committee will decide any matters not specifically covered by these rules.
7. Two or more growers on the one property must stage as a single exhibitor except that a Junior member may exhibit in the Junior category, where one available.
8. All exhibits must be clearly labelled with the plant name by the exhibitor prior to registration. Note below, this will be by electronically printed cards as provided by SADOC for uniformity.
9. All exhibits become the property of the Club for the duration of the Show. No plant or flower may be removed from the Show without permission and being accompanied by the Show Marshall or his/her assistants. The Show Marshall and assistants will be responsible for the benching of all exhibits.
10. In all cases, the Judge's decision is final.
11. If in the Judges opinion an exhibit in any class does not warrant a prize, then a prize will not be given.
12. No person is permitted to handle any exhibit (plants or flowers) during the Show. Should attention to any plant be required the matter should be referred to the Show Marshall or assistants.
13. The SADOC reserves the right to photograph, for its own purpose only, any exhibit in the Show.
14. No plants in flower, except orchids, are allowed on the show benches.
15. All plants exhibited, or for sale, must be in a healthy condition and any plant, which, in the opinion of the Show Marshall and/or Show Committee, does not meet this condition, will be refused entry.
16. Submissions of plants for sale will be restricted to exhibitors or personnel as approved by the Show Committee at the maximum rate of 10 plants per each exhibit with a maximum of 50 plants per day, at 10% commission to the Club.
17. If exhibitors wish to make a voluntary change of section they must nominate for that section at last one full week (seven days) prior to the Show on the appropriate form. Once an exhibitor has been elected to nominate for a higher section, this position cannot be reversed. This provision also applies to the junior section.

18. Cymbidiums will be judged to the following criteria, as per the prevailing OSCOV Award Standard:
- Large Flowered Cymbidiums: over 90 mm (widest point).
 - Intermediate Flowered Cymbidiums: majority between 65 mm and 90 mm (widest point).
 - Small Flowered Cymbidiums: majority less than 65mm across the widest point).
19. Extra classes may be created at the discretion of the Judging Panel.
20. Seedlings are to be judged on potential. A seedling is defined as the entire clone flowering for the first time, not a plant that the exhibitor has flowered for the first time. Flower count should be commensurate with the size of the plant.
21. The Show results will be made available to SADOc members and put on the SADOc Facebook page. Other Clubs that normally receive SADOc newsletters will also receive a copy of the results.
22. Any queries or concerns (other than judging queries or concerns) arising in relation to the Show may be finally determined by the Show Marshall or Show Committee.

LABELLING OF PLANTS

- The exhibitor will mark every plant entered with the name of the plant clearly printed on a PLAIN WHITE card approximately 75mm x 50mm with no borders or other decoration. Cards are now printed by the Show Registrar, and arrangements can be made for this to be done prior to the Show (preferred where large numbers) or prior to registration on the day.
- When registering your plants at the Show the registrar will need the following information:
 - Your name. An exhibitor number will be issued to you.
 - How many plants you are entering.
 - How many seedlings you are entering.
 - If you won a sash, medal or an award at any show.
- Your exhibitor number must be placed on the bottom right of the plant name card followed by the plant number.
- The stewards benching the plants will make sure all plants are set in the appropriate classes and displayed for best effect.
- The Judges will pick up any discrepancies and judge all plants in the correct class.
