Estimate of Full Assessment Costs (based on typical requirements)

- Full assessment + brief report (not for funding purposes), 6 hours total = \$1980
- Full assessment + comprehensive report (e.g. for funding), 8 hours = \$2640
- Medicolegal assessment + comprehensive report, 14 hours = \$5110 (ex GST)

Cancellation Fees

0-24 hours notice: Full fee (for assessments, cancellation fee is \$1320)

24-48 hours notice: 50% of fee (for assessments, cancellation fee is \$660)

More than 48 hours notice: No fee

Please note we will be reasonable and use our discretion regarding cancellation fees incurred due to unavoidable circumstances. You may be required to provide evidence such as a medical certificate.

Explanatory Notes:

1. All neuropsychological assessments require a deposit to secure the booking, equivalent to 3 hours of assessment (\$990 not including GST). This amount will be deducted from the final invoice for the assessment. Neuropsychological assessment includes a comprehensive interview, cognitive testing, questionnaires and scoring of those tests.
2. GST is not applicable for private neuropsychology clients where we provide services directly to the client and they pay for the service. GST is applicable for services provided to private companies or government departments who is paying on behalf of a client (with some exceptions).
3. Reduced fees will be offered for Registrars or for secondary supervision arrangements.
4. Court attendance includes waiting time and provision of testimony. Travel fees to and from court will be charged as per the 'Travel time' rate in the table above.
5. Travel time will be charged for regional assessments outside of the metropolitan area.
6. Please be advised that neuropsychological services are not typically covered under Medicare as per the current schedule.
7. Medicare rebates for the initial consultation can be arranged if you have a referral from your GP under a Mental Health Care Plan. You will be required to pay the full amount and then claim the rebate from Medicare using your receipt.
8. Medicare rebates are also available for the psychology component of a multi-disciplinary neurodevelopmental assessment (e.g. autism diagnostic assessment), but only if referred by a Paediatrician or Psychiatrist under MBS item number 135. The psychology component of an assessment (such as for ASD, item number 82000), can typically attract a maximum of \$406.20 rebate off the total invoice amount.

Payment Terms and Conditions

- **Full payment is required on the day of service** (i.e. payment of initial consult, or full assessment fee on completion of the assessment). We will not release your report until full payment has been received.
- Payment can be made via EFTPOS terminal using direct debit or credit card or by bank transfer. Transaction fees of 1.95% apply to online payments using debit/credit card. We do not have cash facilities. If you have already provided your

debit/credit card details online (by paying an earlier invoice through Stripe), we can automatically deduct further fees with your agreement.

- Payment plans may be available if you are unable to finalise payment on the day, please discuss this with your psychologist.
- We do not offer Bulk Billing services.
- Rebates may be available through your private health insurance depending on your policy cover. We are not able to process private health rebates at our office and you will need to follow this up afterwards using the receipt and relevant item numbers.
- Fees for completed assessment work and report writing are non-refundable once the service has been provided.
- If there is a Service Agreement to provide services, such as with a NDIS provider (plan-managed), and there is insufficient funds to pay for the services already provided, the client accepts full responsibility for payment of the outstanding amounts.
- Refunds are not provided for change of mind, late cancellations, or non-attendance. Deposits are non-refundable where cancellation occurs within 48 hours. If there is a discrepancy between the deposit amount and the cancellation fee above, the difference will be refunded to your payment method.
- However, this policy does not limit any rights you may have under the Australian Consumer Law. Where required, remedies such as a refund or re-supply of services will be provided in accordance with the Australian Consumer Law.
